As you may already know, the Dyslexia Research Trust – an Oxford-based charity with very close links to the University of Oxford - has for many years supported world-class scientific research into dyslexia and related conditions such as dyspraxia and ADHD, with the aim of improving both the identification and the management of these specific learning difficulties.

The pioneering work of Professor John Stein and Dr Sue Fowler first established the role that visual processing can play in dyslexia, and the DRT supports research clinics that lead the field in assessing and treating such visual problems. More recently, treatment trials led by Dr Alex Richardson have shown that certain dietary supplements (containing fatty acids from fish oil and evening primrose oil) can improve concentration and reduce behaviour problems in children with dyslexic and ADHD-type difficulties. The Trust's researchers are also involved in the world's leading programme of research into genetic factors in dyslexia.

DRT researchers have always done their best to make their findings available, and they regularly give talks and lectures to both public and professional audiences. However, media attention following recent research breakthroughs has led to an unprecedented number of enquiries and requests for information. To meet this demand, the DRT has launched a new membership scheme, which you are warmly invited to join. DRT members are kept up to date with our special quarterly newsletter, 'Network', providing:

- the latest news on research into dyslexia and related conditions
- special feature articles to inform both parents and professionals about evidence-based methods of identification and management
